BACHELOR DEGREE PROGRAMS



BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN HEALTH SCIENCES

PSI's Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences degree (BSHS) program is designed for students who already hold an Associate of Applied Science degree in a health care field. This BSHS degree program builds upon your current experience and provides a variety of career options after completion. Graduates of the BSHS program may transfer/enroll to a graduate-level health care career program that may include, but is not limited to, Doctor of Physical Therapy, Nurse Practitioner, Physician Assistant, Athletic Trainer, and Prosthetist/Orthotist. Some additional courses may be required for various graduate programs. For graduates opting to enter the workforce directly after graduation, the additional earned bachelor's degree will provide career advancement opportunity and upward economic mobility.

LPN TO RN BRIDGE

The LPN to RN Bridge program is meant for Licensed Practical Nurses who have completed a practical nursing program and have already earned a diploma with at least 48 quarter credit hours, or the equivalent in semester hours. Upon successful completion of the program, the graduate will be eligible to apply to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN).



PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT

The Physical Therapist Assistant program includes general education and technical physical therapist assistant courses as well as practical clinical experience. Upon successful completion of the program, graduates will be eligible to apply to take the National Physical Therapy Exam through the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy.

The Practical Nurse program is designed to provide the theoretical knowledge and clinical competence necessary to prepare competent and caring practical nursing graduates for entry-level positions under the direction of a Registered Nurse, Physician, Nurse Practitioner or Physician's Assistant. Upon successful completion of the program, the graduate will be eligible to apply to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN).
